Members use of facilities at Nora

Membership is available in 3 options, Standard Plus and Tent.

Standard Off Road membership entitles the individual to be a membership of DDRCC.

You will only be charged members race fees for all club meetings.

You must supply your own pits and power at all meetings.

You may make use of the track and rostrum any time the club does not have an organized meeting planned.

No practice allowed when track maintenance in progress.

You will be supplied a key for the main entrance (£2 deposit required).

If membership is not renewed then keys must be returned by 1st January to the club of that membership year.

Membership and it's benefits are not transferrable to anyone else.

Anyone that opens the main gate must close it again on leaving unless the moto x is on.

Entrance to the track is via the South entrance only.

NORA + membership entitles the individual to all of the above.

In addition you will be supplied a key for the race pits container (£2 deposit required).

The club will supply power on a best effort basis to everyone via a generator, there may be limitations on what can be plugged into the supply so that everyone has a fair share.

The club may make a small charge to cover the cost of fuel used by members when a club race meeting is held.

The use of the club generator is available (at the track) out-with organized club meetings, but any fuel used must be replenished by the individuals using it.

The club are not responsible for any damage caused by the generator etc.

There will be no access to the race control container.

There will be no lap counting facilities out-with organized club meetings.

Nora Tent membership entitles the individual to all the standard off road membership.

Any tent pitting member not willing to actively help with the pitching or removal of the tent will have their membership revoked, NO refund applicable.
